

Design meets flexibility: the new Sanbath washbasins from wedi

Clean lines and generous surfaces are increasingly in demand, while installation on site must remain quick and reliable. With its new Sanbath washbasin range, wedi introduces two new solutions that combine design freedom, contemporary aesthetics and straightforward installation. The wedi Sanbath Flex washbasin can be cut to size, while the wedi Sanbath Modular washbasin can be configured to suit individual project requirements.

With the new Sanbath range, wedi is positioning itself in the segment of prefabricated, tileable washbasins. "The sanitary market is evolving. Customer expectations are becoming more design-led and individual, while time pressure and cost sensitivity continue to increase," says Vera Ulisch, Product Manager at wedi. In response, the bathroom and wet room specialist has developed a clearly defined washbasin range that integrates seamlessly into the wedi system. It combines design and flexibility with a high level of prefabrication, while maintaining strong focus on cost efficiency.

Cut to size on site

The wedi Sanbath Flex washbasin is part of the standard range and therefore available from stock. With dimensions of 1200 x 500 x 120 mm, it offers a generous surface while allowing flexible adjustment to the required length. Continuous installations can be created without visible joints, enabling clean, uninterrupted lines in the bathroom without the need for additional on-site modifications.

With a load capacity of up to 150 kilograms, the washbasin is both robust and durable. The supplied brackets enable quick and secure installation – whether during the construction phase or in a fully finished bathroom. The washbasin can be fully tiled and adapted to any material or colour concept. "Our aim was to develop a solution that delivers on design while reducing installation effort," explains Vera Ulisch. "Measure, cut, fix and tile – the process should be as quick and straightforward as possible."

Modular concept

For projects with clearly defined design requirements, the Sanbath Modular washbasin is available in six configurations. Users can select the washbasin size and choose between versions with or without side ledges. The system can then be combined either with a wedi Fundo standard channel cover or with the slimline 5 mm wedi Fundoshower channel 1.0. The tap mounting is factory-integrated, and the washbasins are supplied ready for installation. The load- capacity is also up to 150 kilograms. "Especially in project business, predictable installation times and defined interfaces are essential," says Ulich. "The modular concept allows for individual bathroom design while keeping on-site processes simple and efficient."

Consistent design within a complete system

Both washbasin variants are fully integrated into the wedi system and are 100% waterproof. In combination with wedi Fundo drain covers and additional system components, washbasin and shower areas can be visually coordinated – for example using the slim Fundo shower channel of the Fundo Flex system for both applications. The result is a consistent overall bathroom design, combined with secure, tested system components from a single source.
