System solutions including design surfaces are a pioneering approach: especially since wedi Top water resistant design surfaces are precisely matched to other wedi system components. They are preformed to fit wedi Fundo shower elements and wedi functional design elements – such as the wedi Sanoasa bench 3 or the wedi Sanwell niche for example. Large-format wedi Top Walls can be used for the cladding of walls and other surfaces in the bathroom. Equally perfect for new builds and refurbishment projects, they transform every bathroom into a modern oasis of well-being in no time at all.

Large-format and easy to install

Only a few steps are required: thanks to their thickness of only 6mm they are not only easy to cut, but also lightweight allowing for a straightforward and easy installation. "Openings, drill holes and gradients are perfectly matched to corresponding wedi XPS elements," says Harnischmacher. The precisely fitting surfaces are simply bonded to the subsurface with wedi 610 adhesive and sealant. In contrast to traditional tiled surfaces, processors save much time since conventional work steps or long drying times are no longer required.

If you need a special format, you can cut wedi Top design surfaces yourself – all you need is a hand-held circular saw.
